Dr. Obiekwe, the president and medical director for Atlanta Ropheka Medical Center, completed his medical training and residency at Emory University's Department of Family and Preventive Medicine, in Atlanta Georgia. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Family Practice, a Board Certified Fellow of the West African College of Surgeon, a Fellow of the International College of Surgeons, and a Board Certified Fellow of the Medical College of Surgeons of Nigeria.

The desire of Dr Obiekwe's heart is to establish sustainable medical clinics in rural parts of Africa that will serve as a vehicle to decrease the prevalence of diseases in any given location by using health education, immunization, and reprogramming the thought and practices of traditional health care givers through workshops and seminars. With this in mind, Arms of Care International was officially created in 2004 as a 501C3 organization. Arms of Care International seeks to facilitate a global health ministry that provides vaccinations, treatments and screening for chronic diseases.
